



Extension of the house and bathing regulations of the Aquella leisure pool under pandemic conditions

This supplement applies in addition to the house and bathing regulations of the Aquella leisure pool and is binding. It amends the house and bathing rules in the relevant regulations or introduces further points. The house and bathing rules as well as this supplement become part of the contract according to § 2 paragraph 1 of the house and bathing rules. The supplement takes up regulations (e.g. official, normative), which serve the protection against infection when using this bath.

§ 1 General principles and behaviour in the bathroom

- (1) The admission of children under 12 years of age is only permitted when accompanied by a parent or guardian or an adult responsible for their care. All attractions and facilities may only be used with parental supervision. Accompanying adults are required to avoid any accumulation and to keep the children at a sufficient distance wherever possible. Further regulations and age restrictions (e.g. sauna facilities, wellness areas, water slides) are possible.
- (2) Persons are only permitted to enter the site after submitting the completed contact tracking form.
- (3) Mouth and nose cover must be worn on the way to and from the parking lots, in front of and in the entrance and cash desk area, in all corridors, the hairdryer places, in the collective changing rooms, changing rooms and changing booths, as long as street clothes are worn.
- (4) Everyone is urged to reduce physical contact with other people outside the members of their own household to an absolutely necessary minimum. Wherever possible, a minimum distance between two persons of 1.5 m must be maintained.
- (5) Only stay directly at the pool entrance and exit. If seats are available at the pool perimeter, they must be at least 1.5 meters away from other people.
- (6) Distance regulations and markings in the area of e.g. water slides, jumping facilities, etc. must be observed. Slides and diving towers may only be used by one person or by a child with a legal guardian, as long as they are not blocked.
- (7) Leave all swimming and bathing pools immediately after swimming and bathing.
- (8) Leave the swimming pool immediately after use and avoid crowds of people on the entire premises (cash desk area, changing room and sanitary facilities, indoor swimming pool and water basin), at public transport stops and in the parking lot.
- (9) Instructions of the staff or other authorized persons must be followed.
- (10) If parts of the bath or sauna cannot be used, this will be pointed out in writing in the entrance area or at the cash desk.

§ 2 General hygiene measures

- (1) Persons with a known/proven infection by the corona virus are not permitted to enter. This also applies to bathers with suspected signs of infection. Among others, access is not permitted to persons who: - show symptoms of Covid-19 (e.g. breathing problems, fever, dry cough, loss of sense of taste or who have had direct contact in the last 14 days with persons suffering from Covid-19. The latter does not apply to healthcare professionals with protected contact with Covid-19 patients.
- (2) Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly. (Hand hygiene)
- (3) Use the hand disinfection stations.
- (4) Cough and sneeze into a handkerchief or alternatively into the crook of your arm (cough and sneeze label)
- (5) Shower before bathing and wash yourself thoroughly with soap. (If the shower rooms are open)
- (6) A mouth-and-nose cover must be worn on the entire premises as long as street clothes are worn as well as in the designated areas. In particular, masks must be worn in front of and in the entrance and cash desk areas, in all corridors, at the hairdryer places, in the collective changing rooms, when waiting in front of wardrobe lockers and changing cabins, in narrow places and according to the official regulations in the designated areas.

§ 3 Measures for keeping a distance

- (1) Observe the current distance rules (e.g. rule of 3, distance 1.5 m) in all rooms. Wait in the marked rooms or in narrow places until the maximum number of persons present is not reached.
- (2) Shower facilities may be entered by a maximum of three persons at the same time. WC facilities may only be entered by individuals, therefore masks are not required. When passing through narrow places, such as the shower facilities, it is recommended to cover mouth and nose (e.g. with a towel).
- (3) There are access restrictions in the swimming and bathing pools. Please observe the information on display and the instructions of the staff.
- (4) In the swimming and bathing pools the required distance must be maintained independently. Avoid the formation of groups, especially at the edge of the pool on the pool resting step or at attractions.
